The Lions Clubs New Zealand Child Mobility Foundation will benefit the community by making provision for young people with limited mobility while being sensitive to their mental and emotional needs.

The Hart Walker

The Hart Walker is a customised orthotic walking frame which has fitted bracing around the child's chest, hips and down the lower limbs to provide support and alignment.

They need adjusted regularly and clinics are held twice a year in Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch and Dunedin.

Lions Clubs assist with organising venues and refreshments for the technicians and families who attend.
